The Carol Sines Memorial Scholarship was established in 1991 as a tribute to Carol Sines for his service. *“To promote thrift among its members and to create a source of credit for them at legitimate rates of interest for provident, productive and educational purposes”* which complements the goals of the Credit Union and is a method to give back to our members.

Carol Sines was the Treasurer of the Credit Union when it existed in a “briefcase” in his bottom desk drawer and was only operated on a part-time basis for a few hours each day. After he retired from the WSDOT, he became the full-time Credit Union Treasurer operating in a 14’ x 70’ mobile home located on the back lot of the WSDOT in Union Gap. He served as Treasurer from 1971 to 1983. After his retirement from the Credit Union, he also served as a volunteer on the Supervisory Committee. Carol was an example of the volunteer spirit and character that established and maintains the Credit Union movement. He could always be counted on to serve on any committee or undertake any project.

The **Carol Sines Memorial Scholarship** is for \$1,500

There are three additional **State Highway District #5 Scholarships** awarded for \$1,000 each.

Eligibility: Must be a member or dependent of a State Highway District #5 Credit Union member.

Enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited College, University or Trade School for the year of application.

Proof of enrollment will be requested prior to payment of scholarship and payment shall be made directly to the school.

Deadline: Postmarked or hand delivered to the Credit Union by May 15th, of the application year.

Essay: (1) State your philosophical, educational and occupational goals in 500 words or less.

(2) State your view on the purpose of Credit Unions. Include an example of a service or a future need that you would like to see implemented and state why in 500 words or less.

(3) Provide a resume including employment, activities, honors, leadership, accomplishments in school, community activities and volunteer capacities.

(4) Provide a statement of financial need showing the following:

- Total anticipated expenses for the year, including tuition, books, transportation and housing costs.
- List the financial aid, scholarships, grants, etc. already received or anticipated.
- List the funds you will receive from other sources, such as parental assistance, employment or gifts.
- Calculate the financial need by subtracting funds received from anticipated expenses.
- Provide any other information you believe would be helpful in assessing your personal or financial need.
